

# One Year Accelerated Massage Therapy Option

## FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH HEALTH SCIENCE BACKGROUNDS

Sutherland-Chan School & Teaching Clinic is pleased to offer an exciting opportunity to become a Registered Massage Therapist. This unique option is now available to graduates of Kinesiology programs and others holding health science related degrees.

**Please note:** admission eligibility is based upon prior learning assessment results. This option meets competency requirements of the College of Massage Therapists of Ontario (CMTO). It makes possible graduation after twelve months of study and gives graduates access to the CMTO entry-to-practice examinations as early as June 2013.

### PART 1 SUMMER BRIDGING June 2012 - August 2012

Your journey towards becoming a registered massage therapist will begin with a 10 week bridging component, which enhances and elaborates on knowledge already gained during your undergraduate studies, and introduces the necessary massage therapy clinical skills.

### PART 2 YEAR 2, S-C DIPLOMA PROGRAM September 2012 - May 2013

Once you complete the Summer Bridging component, you enter into the second year of the two year diploma program, taking a variety of academic and practical courses and participating in our excellent clinical and outreach practicum. Second year is divided into two terms (Terms 3 and 4) which build on the skills and knowledge acquired, and challenge the student therapist with more in-depth study and increasingly more comprehensive clinical opportunities. Students will regularly meet with the Student Services Coordinators to ensure that they are handling the program well. These times will also be used for additional sessions as required by the group or individuals.
